

Purchase of Restricted Items Policy

This policy defines restricted items and the guidelines that must be followed for such purchases.

In the course of their work, University staff, faculty and students routinely use a variety of potentially hazardous materials, safety-critical equipment, radioactive materials, vertebrate animals, and controlled substances in research. The University permits these uses, but only with oversight to ensure safety and compliance with relevant restrictions and regulatory requirements. In addition to the rules governing
